LAMDA Speech and Drama: The girls follow the LAMDA syllabus and have the opportunity to take exams in Verse & Prose, Acting, Devised Performance, Spoken English, Mime, Public Speaking and Reading for Performance from Grade 1 - Grade 8/Gold Medal. LAMDA exams are held 3 times a year. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.

LAMDA Musical Theatre: The girls follow the LAMDA Musical Theatre syllabus and can take Solo, Duo or Group examinations. They have the opportunity to develop and enhance their skills in Musical Theatre - not just in acting, but also in singing and movement. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.

Classical Ballet: The girls follow the RAD syllabus (Royal Academy of Dance) and have the opportunity to take Graded & Vocational examinations. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points. Lessons can also be taken as a recreational activity.

Street Dance: The girls have the opportunity to learn some of the best dance moves as seen on TV and Film. These classes are a great way to learn dance, keep fit and have fun at the same time.

ISTD Modern Dance: The girls follow the ISTD syllabus and have the opportunity to take Graded & Vocational examinations.



Contemporary Dance: This is an expressive form of dance that combines elements of several dance genres including modern, jazz, lyrical and classical ballet. Contemporary dancers strive to connect the mind and the body through fluid dance movements.

Tap Dance: Tap has its roots in Harlem, USA. It involves the use of the ankles and feet incorporating different beats and rhythms to music. Not only is it a very popular form of dance but it's good fun too!

Acrobatic Arts: Acro is a form of movement which combines dance with gymnastics. While all dance is physical, Acro is particularly athletic and has unique choreography due to its use of acrobatics in a dance environment. It seamlessly fuses elements of lyrical gymnastics, tricks, balancing, tumbling, ballet and jazz

Pilates - Yoga - Personal Training - Judo A full range of bespoke "Well-Being and Fitness" Classes (Pilates, Yoga, Relaxation, Exam Stress Management, Judo and Personal Training) are on offer to suit the girls' preferences. Terms and Conditions

FEES: Fees are based on 10 lessons per term. Lessons above or below this number will be paid pro rata. Extra lessons may be scheduled during the school holidays or at any time by mutual agreement. Fees will be reviewed annually. Payment is due in the first week of each term. Late fees will be subject to a 10% surcharge.

MISSED LESSONS: If the teacher is unavailable to give any scheduled lesson, the lesson will be carried forward to another date. If this is not possible, any fee already paid will be refunded. Any lesson missed by the Pupil will be charged.

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT: A decision to discontinue lessons may be taken by the Parent/Guardian or the Teacher, in which case half a term's written notice to finish at the end of a term shall be given by either party. In the event that the Pupil discontinues lessons with insufficient notice, the Parent/Guardian will be liable to pay the fees for those lessons not taken during the notice period.

GENERAL: The Parent/Guardian agrees to pay for any additional equipment required by the pupil and provided by the Teacher. These costs must be paid for in advance direct to Envy Performing Arts.
