LAMDA Speech & Drama

Students follow the LAMDA syllabus and have the opportunity to take exams in Verse & Prose, Acting, Devised Performance, Spoken English, Mime, Speaking in Public and Reading for Performance from Grades 1-8 (Gold Medal). LAMDA exams are held four times a year. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.



LAMDA Musical Theatre

Students follow the LAMDA Musical Theatre syllabus and can take Solo, Duo or Group examinations. They have the opportunity to develop and enhance their skills in Musical Theatre - not just in acting, but also in singing and movement. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.

Classical Ballet (RAD) & Pointe

Students follow the RAD syllabus (Royal Academy of Dance) and have the opportunity to take Vocational and Graded examinations. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.

Lessons can also be taken as a recreational activity.





Contemporary Dance

Students have the opportunity to learn and develop expressive dance skills through contemporary dance which combines elements of several dance genres including modern, jazz, lyrical and classical ballet.

Street Dance

Students can learn some of the best dance moves as seen on TV and Film. These classes are a great way to learn dance, keep fit and have fun at the same time.

Tap Dance

Tap has its roots in Harlem, USA. It involves the use of the ankles and feet incorporating different beats and rhythms to music. Not only is it a very popular form of dance but it's good fun too!

Acrobatic Arts

Acro is a form of movement which combines dance with gymnastics. While all dance is physical, Acro is particularly athletic and has unique choreography due to its use of acrobatics in a dance environment. It seamlessly fuses elements of lyrical gymnastics, tricks, balancing, tumbling, ballet and jazz dance.

Pilates/Yoga/Personal Training

Results 2022-2024

LAMDA – Congratulations to our Heathfield LAMDA students who have successfully taken 130 examinations with 100% Distinction/Merit. This includes 23 Senior Medals at Grades 6-8, which are awarded up to 30 UCAS points.

RAD Ballet – Congratulations to our Heathfield ballerinas who have achieved success in RAD Graded and Vocational Examinations from Grade 4 – Advanced 1.

Dance GCSE – Congratulations to Sasha (Form 5 2023) who completed the AQA Dance GCSE Course in Summer 2022 in Form 4. She studied this as an evening course, both online through lockdowns and in person. Sasha achieved a Grade 9, with full marks in her Practical Dance Units.

LVS Performing Arts Festival – Congratulations to actress Joy J (who was awarded a Silver Medal for Acting) and Street Dancers, Precious, Kokoro, Violet, Tamara (Gold Medal for Quartet Dance Group). The Dance Group also won the Cup for the Best Small Group in the Festival.

Terms and Conditions

FEES: Fees are based on 10 lessons per term. Lessons above or below this number will be paid pro rata. Extra lessons may be scheduled during the school holidays or at any time by mutual agreement. Fees will be reviewed annually. Payment is due in the first week of each term. Late fees will be subject to a 10% surcharge.

ADMINISTRATION/MISSED LESSONS: Requests to change lesson times should be made at least 24 hours in advance and by 3.30pm on a Thursday for the following Monday. Whilst every effort will be made, requests for a change of lesson time received on the day of the lesson cannot be guaranteed. The onus lies with students to rearrange lessons they cannot attend due to other school commitments. Only in exceptional circumstances will refunds be made for missed lessons. All lessons where the teacher is present must be paid for regardless of whether the student attends. If the teacher is unavailable to give a scheduled lesson, the lesson will be carried forward to another date. If this is not possible, any fee already paid will be credited.

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT: A decision to discontinue lessons may be taken by the Parent/Guardian or the Teacher, in which case **half a term's written notice to finish at the end of a term shall be given by either party**. In the event that the Pupil discontinues lessons with insufficient notice, the Parent/Guardian will be liable to pay the fees for those lessons not taken during the notice period.

GENERAL: The Parent/Guardian agrees to pay for any exam fees or additional equipment required by the student and provided by the Teacher. These costs must be paid for in advance direct to NVSDD/Envy Performing Arts. We will inform you if your child is ready to take an exam in their chosen discipline and the entry and administration of this will be done by the Envy Performing Arts Office. Most exams are taken in school with a visiting examiner, but it is sometimes necessary to take students out of school to other centres.
