## at Barfield School, Farnham

**Envy Performing Arts** (in association with NVSDD) has provided expert BALLET tuition at Barfield School for over 7 years. These fun and inclusive classes run on a Wednesday through term time and are timetabled by the Director of Performing Arts.

### Ballet at Barfield

---

Ballet lessons at Barfield are open to all pupils from Owlets to Year 6. All children have the opportunity to perform in the Ballet Showcase in the Summer Term and at other Performing Arts events. Older dancers have the chance to take RAD (Royal Academy of Dance) Awards and Examinations.

Classes are taught by Miss Emily, who is an ex professional ballerina.

***Current Ballet pupils do not need to re-enrol, as registration is on-going, unless notice is given. Pupils wishing to start Ballet should contact the Barfield School Office.***

### The Benefits of Ballet

---

All forms of dance movement, including ballet, naturally support the development of fine motor skills, coordination, balance, and body control. In addition to these physical benefits, boys and girls also develop a strong sense of musicality while exploring creativity and expression through storytelling and the use of props.

Research has shown that one of the most significant and widespread benefits of dance classes is improved self-confidence. As children learn to express their emotions and feelings through movement, they gain new ways to communicate, helping to build confidence and self-awareness. Ballet also fosters teamwork, as children learn choreography together, take turns, and share in collaborative experiences.

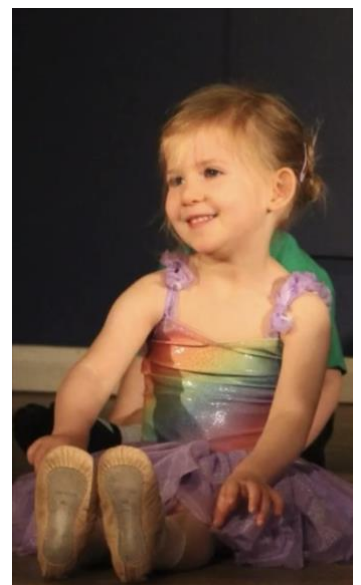
