Envy Performing Arts (in association with NVSDD) has provided expert tuition at Salesian College for 5 years and has a team of experienced teachers who offer lessons through the school day.

LAMDA Speech & Drama

Students follow the LAMDA syllabus and have the opportunity to take exams in Verse & Prose, Acting, Speaking in Public and Reading for Performance from Grades 1-8 (Gold Medal). Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.

LAMDA Musical Theatre

Students follow the LAMDA Musical Theatre syllabus and can take Solo or Duo examinations. They have the opportunity to develop and enhance their skills in Musical Theatre - not just in acting, but also in singing and movement. Grades 6-8 are awarded UCAS points.

LAMDA exams are held yearly in May, with further opportunities to take examinations at one of our other local branches in the Autumn and Spring Terms.

Recognised Awards Scheme: Recognised School

We recommend LAMDA classes to students who:

- are keen actors and want to refine their performance skills
- love Drama or Musical Theatre but do not necessarily want to take a drama GCSE or A Level
- want to develop presentation skills in preparation for GCSE English, College, University and careers
- lack confidence in presentation skills and would like to gain experience in performance and/or speaking in public. Presenting work in seminars is an increasingly important component of further education.

LAMDA Exams gain UCAS points (QCA Accreditation). LAMDA Examinations are accredited by the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA) in England and the corresponding regulatory authorities in Wales and Northern Ireland. LAMDA qualifications are part of the National Qualifications Framework and equate with other qualifications within the sector. LAMDA examinations are recognised as a worthwhile and important qualification by universities or potential employers. The LAMDA Advanced Level Speech & Drama examinations are accredited by the National Qualifications Framework at Level 3 and included in the UCAS Tariff.

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Results 2021-2025

LAMDA Examinations 2025 – 30 Examinations taken. Results pending.

LAMDA Examinations 2024 – 34 students took examinations. 100% Distinction and Merit, with 91% achieving the top mark.

LAMDA Examinations 2023 – 41 examinations completed. 100% Distinction/Merit and over 80% of students were awarded the top grade, Distinction. Special mention to Dhruv C who received 98% Distinction for the LAMDA Grade 8 Speaking in Public Examination. (30 UCAS points)

LAMDA Examinations 2022 – 44 students achieved 100% Distinction/Merit in their examinations ranging from Grade 2 to Grade 8. The higher grades (Grade 6-8) were awarded UCAS Points.

LAMDA Examinations 2021 – Our first cohort of LAMDA students at Salesian College were awarded extremely high marks, with 30 Distinctions and 18 Merits.

Students have the opportunity to perform their LAMDA scenes in the Summer Arts Concerts (Year 7-9 and Year 10-13) and at other events through the school year.



Terms and Conditions

- FEES are based on 10 lessons per term. Lessons above or below this number will be charged pro rata. Payment is due in the first week of each term. Late fees will be subject to a 10% surcharge.
- ADMINISTRATION/MISSED LESSONS: If the teacher is unavailable to give any scheduled lesson, the lesson will be carried forward to another date. If this is not possible, any fee already paid will be credited. Any lesson missed by the Pupil will be charged.
- YEARS 7-9: LAMDA lessons for boys in Year 7-9 at Salesian College will operate on a ROTATIONAL basis – the same as Private Music Lessons. It will not be possible for parents to request which lessons are missed.
- YEAR 10 and above: Where possible, LAMDA lessons for students in Year 10+ at Salesian College will be in a "fixed" lunch-time period or in a Study Period.
- FEES will be reviewed in June 2026
- The parent/guardian agrees to pay for any additional equipment/examination costs. Parents will be notified of these costs prior to purchase/submission.
- LAMDA examinations, if taken, will be charged separately. (LAMDA examinations are usually a 20-30 week study, dependent on the level of the examination)
- The parent/guardian gives permission for the teacher to use the student's photograph in any promotional material. Please give written notice if this permission is not granted.
- Notice, in writing, is due by HALF TERM, to stop at the end of a Term, or a full terms fee will be due in lieu.
